



Guided tour of Old Quebec

Tour guide: Simon the Guide

Starting point: Citadelle de Québec

Highlights: St. Louis Gate and Fortifications; Tourny Fountain; Augustine Convent; Séminaire de Québec; Holy Trinity Cathedral; Dufferin Terrace; Château Frontenac;

Lower Town; Place Royale; Quebec Fresco.

**Note: Tour covers a distance of about 3.5 km and lasts 2.5 to 3 hours, with stops on the way. Be sure to bring appropriate footwear and clothing.

Visit to Artillery Park Heritage Site, National Historic Site of Canada

This site is included on the tour, and includes the famous scale model of Quebec, created between 1806 and 1808 by draftsman Jean-Baptiste Duberger and British Royal Engineer John By.

Funicular, optional (\$)

Some visitors may wish to ride the funicular between Dufferin Terrace and Lower Town.











Domaine Cataraqui, Quebec City

The history of Cataraqui dates back to 1831 when timber merchant James Bell Forsyth established an estate here, naming it in honour of his native Kingston (formerly Fort Cataraqui) in Upper Canada. Henry Burstall, another timber merchant, acquired the property, and it was he who constructed the villa we see today. Cataraqui was leased for a time by the Governor General of the Province of Canada, and in 1860 it was enlarged to accommodate Edward, the Price of Wales. Banker and importer Charles

Eleazar Levey acquired the property in 1863, adding greenhouses and a new wing to the building. The Rhodes family acquired Cataraqui in 1905. Catherine Rhodes and her husband Percyval Tudor-Hart returned the estate's English gardens to their former glory. Eventually, the Government of Quebec acquired Cataraqui, recognizing it as a historic site in 1975. In 1995, Cataraqui became a garden-museum. Today, it is owned by the Commission de la capitale nationale du Québec.
